Honoring Educators AVMB's Teachers' Day Celebration 4th September 2025












AVMB Updates Skills Through NABET Training 10th September 2025









Nurturing Language and Culture Hindi Week 2025 at AVMB 8th to12th September 2025











Regular Practice of Activity-Based Learning with TLMs


